

OPERATION HERO is a free 10-week, structured after school enrichment program which meets 2-times a week, for 2 hours.

Hero facilitators guide children through each session of the curriculum designed by the ASYMCA. Within the first hour, facilitators oversee homework completion.

Children are supervised as they enjoy a short recess, followed by a replenishing snack.

Children learn various life-skill exercises, and explore things such as

- ◇ who they are and,
- ◇ how they fit in at home, school
- ◇ how to work as team players
- ◇ manage feelings
- ◇ make friends
- ◇ accept responsibilities
- ◇ resolve conflicts

Before the day's session ends, they write their own thoughts in their own personal journal.
